Minutes: For procedural reasons, item **OS_2022.1** was withdrawn.

OS_2022.2 To appoint a Chairman for the current municipal year.

Motion: It was moved by Cllr Simon Budd (Mayor), supported by Cllr Patricia

Morgan, and resolved that:

Resolved: Cllr David Somers (Deputy Mayor) is appointed as the Chairman of the

Open Spaces Committee for the municipal year.

OS 2022.3 Declaration of interest – Localism Act 2011.

Minutes: There were no declarations of interest.

OS_2022.4 To receive representations from the press and public.

OS_2022.5 To approve the minutes of the 10th May 2022 meeting.

OS_2022.6 Outstanding items from the previous minutes.

Minutes: The Committee Clerk informed the meeting that he will request quotes

to plant a tree at Blackhorse Road common.

OS_2022.7 Correspondence.

OS_2022.8 Recycled plastic bollards.

Motion: It was moved by Cllr David Somers (Deputy Mayor), supported by Cllr

Roberta Sunderland, and resolved that:

Clerk to install up to 30 bollards as proposed, documents having been

circulated.

OS_2022.9 Planters.

Motion: It was moved by Cllr Roberta Sunderland, supported by Cllr Patricia

Morgan, and resolved that:

Resolved: The Open Spaces Committee agrees to the Friends of Emersons

Green Park planting up the planters in Emerson Way as proposed,

documents having been circulated, with a budget of £300.

OS_2022.10 Dual purpose bin.

Minutes: The Committee noted a request for a bin at the entrance to Emersons

Green Park that is near to the Langley Arms.

Action: Cllr Roberta Sunderland agreed to do a motion request form.

OS_2022.11 Herbicides and pesticides.

Minutes: The Committee noted the proposals provided by Cllr Roberta

Sunderland to implement a strategy to reduce the use of pesticides and

herbicides by the Council's allotment tenants. Following this it was

resolved that:

Resolved: Cllr Roberta Sunderland and the Committee Clerk will prepare a survey

to send to the allotment tenants to find out current practices and to assess how open tenants would be to becoming pesticide and

herbicide free.

OS_2022.12 Allotments evening.

Motion: It was moved by Cllr David Somers (Deputy Mayor), supported by Cllr

Simon Budd (Mayor), and resolved that:

Resolved: The Open Spaces Committee hold an allotments evening as proposed,

documents having been circulated.

Action: The Committee Clerk to invite Chris Sunderland to do a talk, on the

work of the Friends of Emersons Green Park, at the allotments evening

to be held on 8th or 17th November depending on his availability. Cllr Roberta Sunderland may also talk about reducing the use of

pesticides and herbicides.

OS_2022.13 Green Lane signage.

Motion: It was moved by Cllr Roberta Sunderland, supported by Cllr Patricia

Morgan, and resolved that:

Resolved: The Open Spaces Committee renews and reviews the signage in

Green Lane as proposed, documents having been circulated, with a

budget of £4,000.

Action: Cllr Roberta Sunderland volunteered to obtain a quote for the signage

and to design one or more signs to replace the ones at Cave Grove to

put to the committee.

OS_2022.14 Mangotsfield Rural Parish Council (MRPC) signage.

Motion: It was moved by Cllr Simon Budd (Mayor), supported by Cllr David

Somers (Deputy Mayor), and resolved that:

Resolved: The Committee Clerk gets quotes to replace the signs that refer to

MRPC, documents having been circulated.

Action: The Committee Clerk to include in the quote requests an extra three

signs each for the "No Parking" and the "Bye Law" signs to hold as

spares.

OS 2022.15 Hedges at the allotments.

Minutes: The Committee Clerk referred the Committee to a plan of a strip of

land, between a property in Meadgate and the allotment site, which is

owned by a building company.

Action: The Committee Clerk to arrange a site visit for the Committee to view

the allotments from the residents' garden at 1400hrs on 13th

September.

OS_2022.16 Den in Green Lane.

Minutes: The Committee Clerk referred the Committee to plans that show there

is a strip of land between Green Lane and the properties in Berkeley Way that is owned by four building companies. Based on a plan provided by Cllr Roberta Sunderland showing the location of the den it

would seem that the den is on the land owned by the building

companies and not in Green Lane.

Action: The Committee may view the area whilst doing another site visit.
