Emersons Green Town Council are on the lookout for a few new councillors to represent the residents of Lyde Green Ward, Emersons Green Ward and Pomphrey Ward. The town council are actively encouraging applications from interested members of the community.

If you think you would like to represent your community and are over 18 years of age, you may be interested in joining us.

What do councillors do?

Decision making – Councillors decide which activities and services to support in the local area, where money should be spent, and what policies should be implemented. They also have a voice in the local planning system.

Monitoring – Councillors make sure that their decisions lead to efficient and effective services by keeping an eye on how well things are working.

Getting involved locally – As local representatives, councillors have responsibilities towards their constituents and local organisations and can get involved by attending meetings of local organisations and taking up issues on behalf of residents.

How much time does it take up?

Being a Town Councillor is an enjoyable way of contributing to your community and helping to make it a better place to live and work and you chose how much time you want to invest. At a minimum there is attendance at monthly meetings which normally take place on the third Thursday evening of each month. There are other committees you can join if you have the time and interest including Finance & Partnerships, Open Spaces and Planning.
