OS_2025.016 Welcome and Introductions.

Minutes: Cllr Bobbie Sunderland welcomed everyone present at the meeting and explained the emergency procedures.

OS_2025.022 Litter bins – Additional empties

A brief discussion took place regarding the importance of local litter bins and the consequences of overflowing bins.

Resolved: The Open Spaces Committee delegates authority to the Committee Clerk to add an additional weekly empty to the two litter bins, at a total annual cost, per bin of £203.82.

OS_2025.023 Parish Memorial Space.

A brief discussion took place regarding the pros and cons of each suggested location.

Resolved: The Open Spaces Committee recommends that the preferred location for the proposed installation is opposite the new senior school on Honeysuckle Road. Should this site prove unavailable, the Committee's second choice would be the alternative location further along Honeysuckle Road.

OS_2025.024 Allotment Gate

A brief discussion was had regarding securing the gate in times of high wind.

Resolved: The Open Spaces Committee delegates authority to the Committee Clerk purchase the Standard Surface Bolt at a cost of £19.89, and complete the installation.
