OS 2025.059 Welcome and Introductions.

Minutes: Cllr Abi Cohen welcomed everyone present at the meeting and explained the

emergency procedures.

OS 2025.060 Declaration of Interest - Localism Act 2011.

**Minutes:** Cllr Abi Cohen reminded members of the requirement to declare an interest.

OS\_2025.061 Public Participation.

**Minutes:** No members of the public were present.

OS 2025.062 Minutes.

**Resolved:** The Minutes of the Open Spaces Committee meeting on **2nd of October** 

2025, copies having been circulated, were approved as a correct record and

signed by the Deputy Chair.

# OS\_2025.063 Outstanding items.

At the invitation of the Deputy Chair, the Committee Clerk circulated a summary of the work undertaken as a result of the resolutions and action points from the previous meetings.

# OS\_2025.064 Correspondence.

Correspondence and responses were noted by the Committee.

## OS 2025.065 Allotment Oaks.

A brief discussion was had regarding the oak's impact on the site, associated risks, and the subsequent enquiries.

#### Resolved:

The Open Spaces Committee approves the recommended removal and the response to the enquiry, including the suggested additions.

# OS\_2025.066 Rodway Common Wall.

A brief discussion took place regarding the research into the alternative options to protect the vandalised wall.

#### Resolved:

The Open Spaces Committee delegates authority to the Committee Clerk to erect the black steel trellis and additional ivy planting, with a budget of £450.

#### OS\_2025.067 Local Climate and Nature Action Plan. (LCNAP)

It was agreed that the review of the LCNAP be deferred to a future meeting to allow consideration by a greater number of Councillors.

#### OS\_2025.068 Emersons Green Lane Speeding.

A brief discussion was had regarding the installation of a sign and possible leaflets.

#### Resolved:

The Open Spaces Committee delegates authority to the Committee Clerk to request further information from South Gloucestershire Council regarding the allowances and constraints for signage. The Committee also requested that a leaflet regarding signposting concerns is drafted and circulated via email.

#### OS\_2025.069 Crocus Road Dog Bin.

A brief discussion was had regarding the evidence of waste being left and the lack of available bins in the area.

#### Resolved:

The Open Spaces Committee delegates authority to the Committee Clerk to install a dual purpose bin at the location at a cost of £672.68. As well as the annual cost for a once a week empty of the bin at £211.64.
