OPERATIONS

FC_2025.032 To note reports from Committees, Working Groups, and External Bodies. Cllr Cohen reported on behalf of the Open Spaces Committee. Key updates and decisions:

- Ongoing Issues: Several projects remain in progress, including noticeboards, park improvements, habitat work, and litter management.
 Notable updates include drone survey data sent for the Rodway bike track and pending life buoy installation at Blackhorse Pond.
- Resident Correspondence: Reports addressed across various sites, including abandoned vehicles, tree concerns, and damaged or missing infrastructure. Some matters referred to South Gloucestershire Council.
- Allotments: Plot conditions have improved; driving restriction breaches and damage reported. Vegetation management planned post-nesting. Contractor praised for grass cutting.
- Memorial/Plaque Policy: Committee declined to introduce a formal policy, citing practical concerns.
- **Bye Mead Open Space:** In-principal support given for wildflower planting and a potential new bench, subject to neighbour consultation.
- Rodway Common (Manor Road Land): Agreed to seek a professional environmental assessment due to unclear site boundaries and potential ecological value.

Cllr Hutter reported on behalf of the **Finance & Partnership Committee**. A grant was provided to Green Community Travel towards marketings, a strimmer was donated to Friends of Emersons Green Park, a funds were provided to Lyde Green Community Association for their Summer Sizzler and other summer activities.

Cllr Budd reported on behalf of the **Planning Committee**. Details were shared regarding an application made by a new off licence, originally requiring permission to open until 2am, but conditional approved given for 11pm closure instead.

Cllr Sunderland reported on behalf of the Climate & Nature Working Group. CNR members are encouraged to complete the ongoing survey, with quarterly participatory meetings planned in response to current feedback. A photography project led by Sharon Townson will feature members' gardens to promote nature-friendly spaces. The Town Council's photography competition received 75 entries, to be judged soon and exhibited at the Autumn Gathering on 4th October 2025, where 2026 calendars will also be available. Upcoming events include Open Gardens on 6th June 2026, and a Clothes Swap on 23rd November 2025 featuring a talk by fashion consultant Becky Barnes, plus refreshments and family activities. Clothes mending service is being considered. A bulb planting volunteer event at Blackhorse Meadow is also planned, pending approval.

Cllr Rachael Hunt provided a report on behalf of **South Gloucestershire Council**. A recent incident on Jenner Boulevard in Lyde Green which resulted in damage to the road surface and therefore closure now has a temporary traffic management solution to retain access. Further work is planned to complete the repairs. The currently closed doctor's surgery is making slow progress and is conscious of preparing for winter pressures that are approaching.
