
Emersons Green Town Council

Emersons Green Town Council organises a **free weekly Coffee Morning** every **Thursday** at **10am** at **Emersons Green Village Hall**, with opportunities for residents to access free, confidential support from Citizens Advice. This welcoming event is designed to foster community connection in a relaxed setting, offering complimentary hot beverages and cake.

In partnership with the Town Council, **Citizens Advice** are available at two locations for drop-in sessions, providing residents with expert guidance on a range of issues:

- Thursdays, 10am-12pm at Emersons Green Village Hall (during the Coffee Morning)
- Mondays, 10am-12pm at Lyde Green Community Centre

These initiatives aim to provide a safe and friendly space for the community to gather, share experiences, and seek professional advice. **Everyone is welcome!**
