Dear Occupier

I am writing to inform you of upcoming National Grid Electricity Distribution (NGED) Network Reinforcement works, which we have planned to start in your area on the 05<sup>th</sup> January 2025. These works will continue through to the end of April 2025. These essential network improvement works are being carried out in phases as stated below and, in most parts, will only be open for shorter durations than the entire date range.

NGED will be installing a new Low Voltage electricity mains cable which is future proofing our Network in readiness for new Low Carbon Technologies such as solar panels, EV chargers and ground source heat pumps. As part of this process NGED will be carrying out excavations as per the attached plan. We understand these works will cause some disruption, however we aim to keep this to a minimum. There will be periods driveway access will be restricted whilst trenching works take place in front of your property. We will ensure these dates and times are communicated in advance of the works.

I apologise in advance for the inconvenience these works will cause. Parking may be compromised and we may seek to have cars moved to allow us to carry out these works if the need so arises.

The dates we will be starting works on each street will be as follows: -

Emet Grove – 05<sup>th</sup> January  
Guest Ave – 13<sup>th</sup> January  
Emersons Green Lane – 19<sup>th</sup> January  
Church Farm Rd – 21<sup>st</sup> January  
Robbins Court – 03<sup>rd</sup> February  
Home Field Close – 27<sup>th</sup> February  
Sarum Close – 11<sup>th</sup> March
