Really pleased to announce this Place Partnership with Emersons Green Town Council 🇬🇧

For years to come, the Community Club on Wheels will now serve the whole parish, which includes over 500 SNG customers in the immediate area of Lyde Green.

What did the place say?
There's been an increase in anti-social behaviour; lack in structured youth provision and available, appropriate space; younger people's confidence falling, online over-reliance, and disconnected from the community at large (🔗 [Emersons Green Youth](#)+internal/external info).

Pioneered by [Shea Stew](#), it will support the incredible work of [Avon and Somerset Police](#), and respond to aims set out in the National Youth Strategy (December '25) led by [Lisa Nandy](#).

The bus serves as a multi-functional mobile hub that offers recreational games, cooking facilities, and a dedicated environment for homework support, guidance, and diversionary activities.

I popped down the other day, and it was great to see younger people and the community coming together, and I can't wait to see the difference this makes over the coming years.

Spring Gathering: Common Connections Celebration



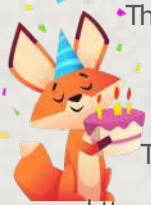
Thank you for a wonderful Spring Gathering!

The bus is here!! Everyone here at Emersons Green Town Council is very excited to announce the new Community Hub on Wheels (CHOW) has been built and is now serving the community.



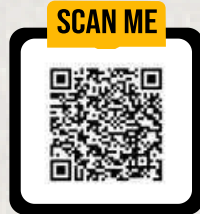
Helping Mangotsfield School Community Hub

A message from our Mayor, James Hunt, reflecting on our end-of-year achievements.

This year, the Town Council has focused heavily on strengthening our community foundation, particularly by investing in our young people and backing local grassroots initiatives.

Key Achievements:

- Revamped Youth Provision: We transformed our youth services with the appointment of a new Youth Officer and the successful launch of our Together Loud youth brand.
- Mobile Outreach: Our new Community Hub on Wheels (CHOW) is now officially active, serving directly in our neighborhoods as a mobile youth centre and outreach point.
- Empowering Local Champions: We provided vital financial backing, advice, and signposting to the groups that keep our community vibrant. This includes supporting the Mangotsfield Festival, Ham Farm Festival, Earthfest, the Friends of Emersons Green Park, and our essential local community hubs and sports clubs.
- Sustaining Essential Services: We continued to commission crucial support services for our residents, ensuring ongoing access to the Citizens Advice Bureau and local library sessions.
