Linking the Greens Project – Temporary Skate Park Closure

News from South Gloucestershire Council:



South Gloucestershire Council will begin Linking the Greens works on the Emersons Green side from 7th April 2026, improving walking and cycling routes between Emersons Green and Lyde Green. Work includes new paths, lighting, landscaping, and a 4-metre sculpture, finishing by late July 2026. Emersons Green Skate Park and part of a nearby footpath will be temporarily closed during the works, with signed diversions in place.
