## Emersons Green Watermark Town



Emersons Green Town Council is pleased to be working with Wessex Water as part of the Watermark Town initiative, supporting local action on water conservation, flood resilience, and environmental improvement.

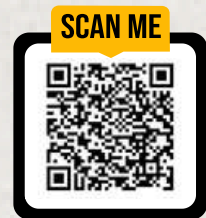

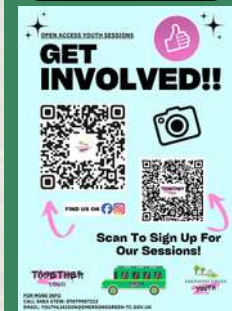


## Pomphrey Hill x Emersons Green Youth

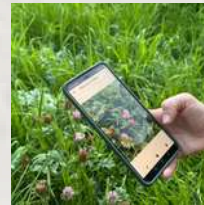


## Is Your Garden Wildlife Friendly?

### Join our Community Nature Reserve



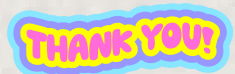

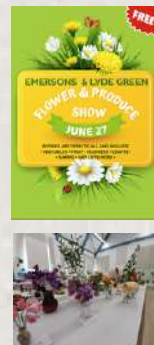


## The Emersons and Lyde Flower Show

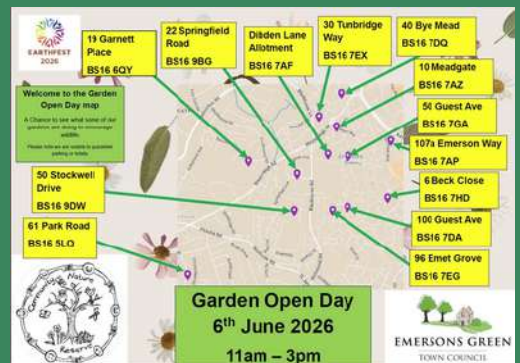


## Open Gardens Saturday 6th June 2026
