Emersons Green Audio Tour

Emersons Green Audio Tour is a free, family-friendly 3.7 mile circular walk exploring the history of Emersons Green, Mangotsfield, and nearby areas.

Starting at Emersons Green Library, the 90-minute route features 14 points of interest, covering local mining heritage, chocolate production, giant earth sculptures, and supercomputers. Scan QR codes along the way to hear audio stories and interviews.

Created by Lenni Langreiter for the Duke of Edinburgh Award in 2024 and now supported by Emersons Green Town Council, the tour is a fun way to get active, explore the outdoors, and discover your local community.

Blackhorse Meadows

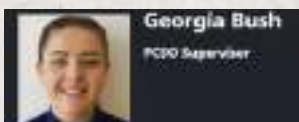
Help Create a Buzz at Blackhorse Meadows!
